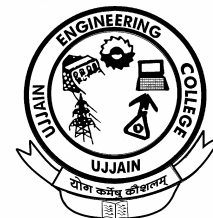

The Host Institutes

Ujjain Engineering College, Ujjain: Formerly known as Govt. Engineering College, was established in 1966 by Govt. of Madhya Pradesh with a view to improve the status of technical education in the region. The institute offers six under graduate courses leading to B. E. degree with an intake of 310 students. The institute also runs three post graduation courses with an intake of 68 students. Institute is RGPV, Bhopal recognized research center.

From the academic year 2009-10, Ujjain Engineering College declared academically autonomous by the Rajiv Gandhi Proudyogiki Vishwavidyalaya Bhopal, the Technological University of M.P. The college has an excellent infrastructure, well equipped laboratories and highly qualified and experienced faculty.

Shiksha Sanskriti Uthan Nyas

To open a new avenue in the educational domain of the country, Shiksha Sanskriti Uthan Nyas was founded in May, 2007. To mould the pattern of country's education according to its culture, nature and pace of development, six basic subjects are selected. These includes: (1) Wholesome development of character and personality (2) Environmental education (3) Vaidic Mathematics (4) Education in mother tongue (5) Autonomy in education (6) Value based education.

To promote Value based education, Nyas is organizing seminars and conferences since last two years in collaboration with the institutions like Dev Sanskrit University, Haridwar, Dr. Ambedkar Open University, Ahamdabad, Jiwaji University, Gwalior, Punjab Technical University, IIT Delhi, IIT Kanpur, IIM Hyderabad etc. Most of these institutions are implementing value based education. To practically apply value based education system in the institutes of Higher Education in the country Nyas along with the institutions organizing conferences, meetings, seminars etc.

"Education has to be changed to effect changes in country and to change education inclusion of values in the education is of primary importance" is the motive of the Nyas.

Ujjain City

Ujjain is considered as one of seven sacred cities in Bharat and is also one of the four centres of twelve yearly Kumbh Mela (Simhastha). The holy city situated on the bank of sacred river Kshripa sees a steady

stream of pilgrims throughout the year. The city has Mahakaleshwar Temple (one of the twelve Jyotirlingas), Kaal Bhairav Temple, Chintaman Ganesh Temple, Harsiddhi Temple, ISCON Temple etc. Ujjain is well connected to all major cities via rail and road. The nearest airport is 55 km away from Ujjain and located at Indore city. During October the climate of Ujjain remains pleasant.
